

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- Reduction to Four Classes => Imperial Power, the cosmological implication of four = completeness

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- Historiographical works „closer“ to the Classics => Confucian Officials in charge of historiography claim increased importance
- With Confucius as author of the *Chunqiu*, this is a „construction of tradition“ for the imperial administration
